1. INTRODUCTION

 Proper seed preservation is crucial for maintaining seed viability and quality

• Taking proper care of seeds ensures the continuation of genetics, unique

plant traits, and characteristics

 Follow these guidelines for storing and preserving seeds to help the successful growth of healthy plants

2. STORING SEEDS

 Dry seeds entirely before storing - use a desiccant like silica gel to remove excess moisture

 Use airtight containers labeled with the date and variety. An airtight container will help prevent moisture buildup and keep seeds viable for years

• Store seeds in a cool, dry location, away from direct sunlight. The ideal storage temperature range is 32°F to 41°F (0°C to 5°C) - avoid freezing seeds

3. GERMINATING SEEDS

• To germinate cannabis seeds, soak them in water to soften the seed coat

before planting

 Place the seeds in a moist paper towel in a sealed plastic bag and keep in a warm, dark place for 24 to 72 hours, checking for sprouts, then plant them in a growing medium with the root pointing downwards
