

OZONE SEED PACKS

1. INTRODUCTION

- Proper seed preservation is crucial for maintaining seed viability and quality
- Taking proper care of seeds ensures the continuation of genetics, unique plant traits, and characteristics
- Follow these guidelines for storing and preserving seeds to help the successful growth of healthy plants

2. STORING SEEDS

- Dry seeds entirely before storing - use a desiccant like silica gel to remove excess moisture
- Use airtight containers labeled with the date and variety. An airtight container will help prevent moisture buildup and keep seeds viable for years
- Store seeds in a cool, dry location, away from direct sunlight. The ideal storage temperature range is 32°F to 41°F (0°C to 5°C) - avoid freezing seeds

3. GERMINATING SEEDS

- To germinate cannabis seeds, soak them in water to soften the seed coat before planting
- Place the seeds in a moist paper towel in a sealed plastic bag and keep in a warm, dark place for 24 to 72 hours, checking for sprouts, then plant them in a growing medium with the root pointing downwards
